Eligible High-Efficiency Products

The following are examples of the types of products eligible for incentives. A complete list of eligible products can be found at efficiencyalberta.ca.

- Efficient interior and exterior lighting products and controls: LED T8s, LED bulbs, LED low/medium/high-bay fixtures, LED exterior fixtures, T5HO high-bay fixtures, occupancy controls, etc.
- Efficient Heating, Ventilation and Air Conditioning (HVAC) equipment: Commercial warm air furnaces, condensing boilers
- Efficient water heating equipment: Condensing water heaters, tankless water heaters
- Variable Frequency Drives

Eligibility and Application Information

All business, non-profit, and institutional customers serviced by an Alberta electric or gas utility are eligible, except for large final emitters—as defined under Alberta’s Specified Gas Emitters Regulation. Examples of eligible organizations include:

- Individual businesses
- Non-profit organizations
- Institutions such as schools, hospitals, universities, and colleges
- Co-operatives

Incentives will be awarded on a first-come, first-served basis for eligible products purchased on or after March 24, 2017 (as per invoice date).

Once your organization has installed an approved high-efficiency product, you can apply for an incentive. Program representatives are available to answer your questions, and can help your organization complete your application.

When your application is approved, you’ll receive a cheque that will help cover the cost of your investment.
