Program Allies are service consultants and specialized equipment firms that include engineering firms, vendors, and installers of high-efficiency industrial and commercial equipment. To be eligible to receive incentives for completing Scoping Audits, Engineering Studies, and Re-Commissioning Investigations, your consultant must be a pre-qualified Program Ally. If your consultant is not on this list the qualification process can be initiated before starting a project application. Companies licensed to do engineering work in Alberta must hold a Permit to Practice issued by The Association of Professional Engineers and Geoscientists of Alberta (APEGA), which can be verified by checking [APEGA's Permit Holder Directory](#).

Implementing a custom project may involve the work of specialized sub-consultants and contractors not listed here. Refer to the [Custom Project Implementation Incentive Terms and Conditions](#) for more information. Some contractors require a business license and some work requires a permit. Before you start working with your contractor, you should ensure that your selected contractor holds a business license if required by the municipality where work is taking place.
